

Class Descriptions

The Learning Center serves children ages one to five. We have both Mother's Day Out and Preschool programs.

Mother's Day Out

The *Little Lamb* and *Teddy Bear* classes are both play based, have a Bible time and rest time. Each class has a long period of time in our courtyard playground or inside pavilion.

The *Little Lambs* class is for children who are one year old by June 1, 2018. The class has six children and two teachers. Children may be registered only for one day of the week.

The *Teddy Bear* class is for children who are two years old by June 1, 2018. The class has ten children and two teachers. Children may come one or two days.

Preschool

The *Junior Preschool* classes are for children who are age 3 by September 1 of 2018. The class has 12 students and two teachers. Our Junior Preschool classes are beginning to understand class routines, circle time and following directions. Our day consists of play, art activities, and large motor time. The children will be introduced to numbers and letters through play. Each class has Bible time each day.

The *Senior Preschool* class is for children who will be eligible for Kindergarten in the fall of 2019. The class has 14 students and two teachers. The Senior Preschool class will be introduced to all of the letters and will learn how to write both upper and lower case. They will also be introduced to the sounds of the letters. They will learn numbers 1-15. All of these skills will be taught through play. This class will also have Bible time each day and large motor time twice a day.

The *Transitional Kindergarten* class is for children who will by age 5 by November 1, 2018 or by teacher recommendation. This class is intended for children who may already be eligible for Kindergarten or just miss the Kindergarten cutoff date. Children in this class will continue with letter recognition, sounds, rhyming and writing letters and words. They will also work on numbers, graphing and patterning. This class will have Bible time each day and large motor time twice a day.
