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PLANS FOR THE 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR

Hours of the school day:

1st to 8th Grade: 8:15AM-3:15PM

K3 to K5: 8:30AM-3PM

Location of classes:

3rd-8th grade classes are located in the gym building.

K5-2nd grade classes are to use the entrance by the school office.

Preschool uses the entrance located through the playground gate.

COVID-19 Protocols:

State law requires our K5-8th grade students and all staff to wear a mask indoors and maintain three ft. distancing when possible. They do not need to wear masks outside. If anyone tests positive for COVID-19, they will need to quarantine and not be at the school under any circumstances. Under CDC guidelines, patients should isolate for at least 10 days or until symptoms have cleared up--whichever is longer.

When a student is exposed to someone who has the virus, but has maintained distance and was wearing a face covering, that student does not need to quarantine unless that student has symptoms. If no face coverings are worn and distancing was not maintained, then they will need to quarantine.

Please note that exposure is different from testing positive. Exposure or “close contact” means being less than 6 feet away, for no longer than 15 cumulative minutes a day, from a person who has COVID-19.

On-site COVID-19 testing is available. Testing is not mandatory. Test results are required to be given to the local health department. We will not be administering testing without written consent from the students’ legal guardian. Please let the office know if you’d like a consent form.



ACA Safety Protocols:

- Students wear a mask when they enter the school building
- Wellness checks as students enter their classroom or building
- Temperatures will be checked when the administrators feel it is necessary
- Students will wear a mask indoors and maintain 3 ft. distancing when possible
- Students will be assigned a cohort
- Windows to be open (weather permitting) and fans blowing to increase fresh outside air
- Emphasize frequent handwashing and hand-sanitizing for students and staff
- Clean and sanitize commonly used areas frequently
- A designated area in the classroom for students who need a mask break

People do not need to wear a mask when:

- Actively eating or drinking
- Playing a musical instrument
- Engaged in a sport during physical education classes.
- In a private workspace
- Is under five years of age
- Is playing a competitive extracurricular sport
- Is outside
- There is a medical exemption (protocol to be taken on a case-by-case basis)

Our goal at ACA is to provide a safe learning environment for all students. This looks different for everyone. We strive to maintain a balanced safety protocol within the means of the OHA guidelines.
