

Guatemala



Good afternoon from the Iglesia de Cristo, La Union, Zacapa, Guatemala. May the peace of Christ be with you.

Here are some of our activities from the months of December and January. We had our VBS (EBV in Spanish – Escuela Biblica de Vacaciones), where we had a great opportunity to teach children the word of God. This year we had a “Coming to the Farm” theme.

On January 10, we had our first activity of the year – our “Vigilia.” This is a vigil to appreciate the coming of sunrise on a Sunday morning, with worship, prayers and praise. 
