

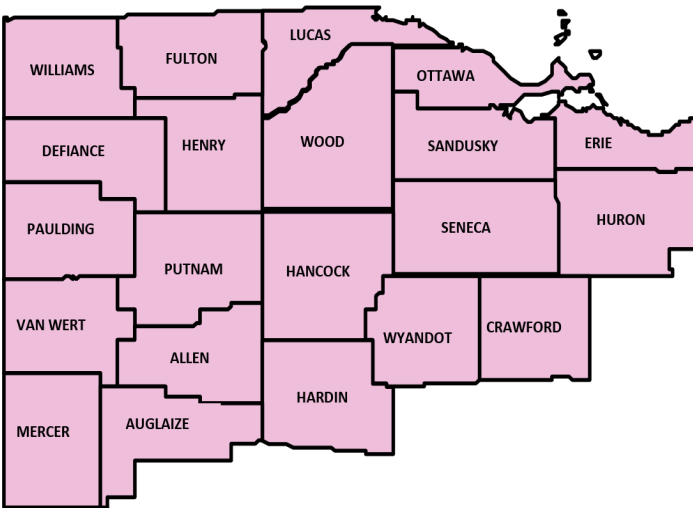
BCCP (BREAST AND CERVICAL CANCER PROJECT)

The Northwest Region Breast and Cervical Cancer Project (BCCP) is a high-quality breast and cervical cancer screening and diagnostic program that serves 21 counties of northwest Ohio.



NORTHWEST OHIO Breast & Cervical CANCER PROJECT

Eligible women can receive services at no-cost. Services may include a pelvic exam, pap test, clinical breast exam, mammogram, and diagnostic testing if needed. Our case managers not only schedule needed screenings, but also provide individualized support and assistance to help women overcome any barriers that may impede their access to breast and cervical screenings.



OCISS indicates that **only 68.7%*** of **Fulton County residents** were **screened for breast cancer** compared to the state rate of 74%.

*This statistic shows that collective efforts in Fulton County should focus on strategies to increase screening rates among residents.

According to the Ohio Cancer Incidence Surveillance System (OCISS), **Fulton County** is among the **lowest** Ohio counties for both **incidence and mortality rates** from breast cancer.

In the past **7 months** BCCP has provided a total of **1,555 services** at **no-cost** to **women in need**.

BCCP has **enrolled 486** women within the first **6 months** of the grant year.
