Soil Evaluation is the examination of the soil characteristics to determine if and what type of a septic system can be installed in the soil being considered.

Site Review is a visit to a specific site after the design plan for a new septic system has been submitted by a designer or installer. This is done to confirm the submitted design can be installed as indicated.

A site review only. In addition, a septic system design with all the required information must be submitted to enable the site review to be completed. If the Health Department did not conduct the soil evaluation, the name and contact number of the soil evaluator and the system designer must be provided along with their completed soil evaluation, system design, and \$68.00 fee.

A site review only. My existing house and parcel are believed to be too small for a soil absorption system and I plan to install a discharging system with a NPDES permit. I understand that two permits are required: one to install the system (Health Dept.) and one to permit the system to discharge (OEPA).
