In 2017, your Fulton County Health Department:

- ◆ Worked with multiple agencies, used data provided by county residents, identified health priorities and developed a Fulton County Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP). Both the data, Community Health Assessment (CHA), and the CHIP are available on our website under the Resources and Data tab. Areas of focus are Mental Health, Addiction, Obesity and Heart Disease.
- ◆ Collaborated with the ADAMhs Board and the Defiance, Henry and Williams County Health Districts to launch a Mental Wellness Campaign encouraging you to take steps to achieve and maintain mental wellness in addition to your physical health.
- ◆ Formed a council of governments with six other northwest Ohio health districts (Defiance, Henry, Paulding, Putnam, Williams, and Wood) to improve efficiency and effectiveness of public health services.
- ◆ Provided essential public health services to support residents in making choices that improve and maintain the health and wellbeing of themselves and their families.

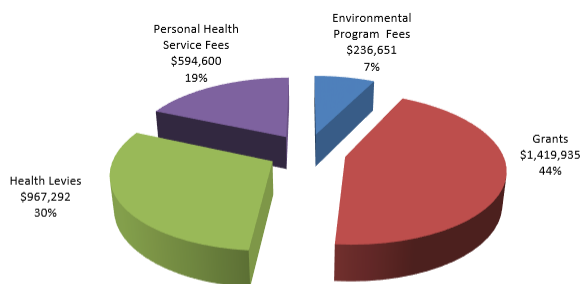

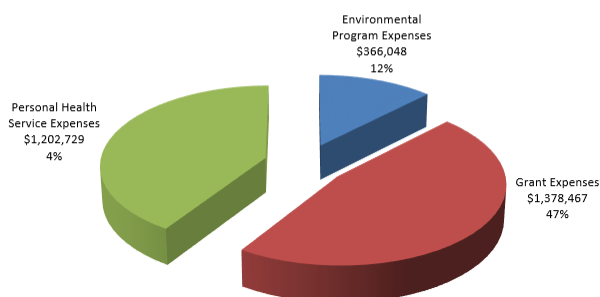
