We have a State of Ohio Vital Statistics Electronic Index Kiosk for customers searching for birth and death records. You can search birth records back to 1908 and death records back to 1964. The information you will need is the person's last name, first name, and year of birth, death, or person's last name and complete date of birth and/or death.



Vital Statistics

The Health Department is the local source to purchase certified birth certificates. Fulton County Health Department can provide a birth certificate for anyone born in the State of Ohio.

Certified copies of death certificates are only issued in the county in which the person died, not necessarily in the county where they lived.
