SECOND MILE IS BEGINNING TO COLLECT FOODS FOR OUR ANNUAL CHRISTMAS BOXES. ITEMS NEEDED INCLUDE CHICKEN ROASTERS, HAM OR SMALL TURKEYS AND SIDES LIKE STUFFING MIXES, CANNED GREEN BEANS, SWEET POTATOES OR YAMS, GRAVY, BOXED POTATOES, CORN BREAD MIXES, BREAD, CRANBERRY SAUCE AND CAKE MIXES AND FROSTING. THE ITEMS CAN BE PLACED IN THE CONTAINERS PROVIDED IN THE LOBBY. IN THE CASE OF THE CHICKEN, HAM AND TURKEY, SINCE THEY NEED TO BE REFRIGERATED OR FROZEN, THEY CAN BE DELIVERED DIRECTLY TO SECOND MILE ON MONDAY MORNINGS BETWEEN 10AM AND 1 PM.
