Location Overview - YouthWorks (Savannah, GA)

Your group will have the opportunity to do hands-on work projects, partner with local ministries and non profit organizations that serve seniors, children and those experiencing homelessness. In the evenings, you'll get to have dinner and swim at Tybee Island, learn about historic injustices by touring a church involved with the underground railroad, take a stroll through the Riverwalk and other tourist destinations in Savannah, and end the week with a community cookout celebration.
