### **Advent Photo Challenge**

I hope you all are enjoying the Advent devotions that were written by different members of the Calvary family—I know I am! But this year Calvary has something else to help us engage in the Advent and Christmas seasons: an Advent Photo Challenge. I have participated in similar challenges before, for different seasons of the church year, and have found them very meaningful. Thinking through the word of that day—which for us correspond to the daily Advent devotions—allowed me to contemplate the season's themes more deeply as I tried to make or find a picture that represented my thoughts. And I know God guided my contemplations to places I would never have gone to by myself.

Here's how it works: from the beginning of Advent to the end of December, every day has been given a word to guide your reflection. Using that word as your guide, take or find a picture for that day and post it on Instagram and/or Facebook along with the hashtag #adventcbc. I always write a little caption, too, explaining how the picture fits the word.For example, for a past photo challenge I did, one day the word was "Brokenness." I took a picture of puzzle pieces and wrote: "This puzzle is in pieces. It is broken. No, we don't think like that. The puzzle isn't broken; it just hasn't been put together yet. And I wonder how many times I've looked at something, some part of my life, and declared it broken, when, in fact, the pieces just haven't been put together yet. God just isn't finished."
