The walls are transported to the home site where **Will County Habitat for Humanity** will complete the house with other volunteers and skilled tradespeople.

PREPARERS

Help plan, prepare, or serve food. (any or all meals)

First Aid volunteers
Help keep area neat and safe during and after the event.
