Ladies, we've come this far by faith...so let's keep our faith press for the future! Now is the time to, "Be alert, stand firm in the faith, be brave, be strong" (1 Corinthians 16:13 GNT) because, "Oh, woman, your faith is something else. What you want is what you get" (Matthew 15:28 TMB)!

LESSON: GOD'S NOT FINISHED

1. What do you do when things don't turn out the way you expected them to?
2. What do you do when God is silent? How do you handle the worst day of your life? How do we trust God in the dark times? What happens when you need a turnaround and you are still waiting?
3. In the Book of Job, we read that Job was the richest man in the east. One day he lost everything. He lost all of his children. He lost all of his crops and livestock (his business). He lost his workers. He even lost his health. This happened all in one day.
4. The Book of Job is the oldest book in the Bible. He existed before Abraham. There were no 10 Commandments. No law that God gave. No prophets. Job's only experience of God was when God spoke to him. Job didn't live under the New Covenant like us. He was not born again and didn't have the promises of God.

8 "Look, I go forward, but He is not *there*,
And backward, but I cannot perceive Him;
9 When He works on the left hand, I cannot behold *Him*;
When He turns to the right hand, I cannot see *Him*.
10 But He knows the way that I take;
When He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold."

Job 23:8-10 NKJV

5. When Job made that statement, he felt abandoned by God. He felt that God didn't care or that He was hiding from Job.
6. Job made that statement out of hurt and pain. He spoke out of discouragement and rejection. Basically, he spoke about God that was not true.
7. Just because someone in the Bible spoke about God that doesn't mean that it's true. They could be speaking against God's character. The enemy would love to sow seeds of confusion in our minds when we go through trials and tribulations. The Bible says that God stays the same and He doesn't change.
8. Don't allow the enemy to sow seeds of doubt in your mind concerning the character of God. We may not know all the answers to life but God is faithful. Don't let something you don't understand blind you to the goodness of God.
9. At the end of the Book of Job, God corrects him and we can see that Job had repented to God. He said, "I've sinned against God." God said, "I am not the One who's caused evil."
10. Job repented before God because he wanted to be right with God. He just didn't know that he was wrong. He allowed other people and his emotions in a difficult time in his life to draw conclusions about God's character. After he repented and prayed for his friends, God restored back unto Job twice as much what the enemy stole.
