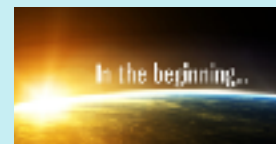

At Camp SMILE, children with Autism, their siblings, and other children with and without special needs are able to make new friends and work together all while having fun. Camp SMILE is comprised of enriching, positive, therapeutic, active, educational and fun recreational activities

—that are tailored to the ability level of the campers. With assistance from many staff and — volunteers (and a ratio of 1 staff member or volunteer to every 3 or 4 campers), these children are also learning new things including communication and social skills, cooperation, teamwork, using positive coping skills to manage feelings and emotions and functional skills.

Camp SMILE is for children ages 5 through 21 and dates, times and locations for the summer of 2015 will be posted as soon as they are confirmed. There are weekly themes and daily activities related to those weekly themes, as well as social skills training.
