

Luke 1:32




#### DAVID'S FAMILY BACKGROUND:

### David mourns the death of Saul and Jonathan (II Samuel 1)


David is the monarch over Judah (II Samuel 2-4)


David merges Judah and Israel at Jerusalem (II Samuel 5-11)


David moves the capital to Jerusalem (II Samuel 5:6-7)

David's great mistake (II Samuel 11)


David makes things right (II Samuel 12:13-18, 23)


David marries Bathsheba and they have Solomon (II Samuel 12:24)


David manages to secure the throne for Solomon (I Kings 1 and 2)
