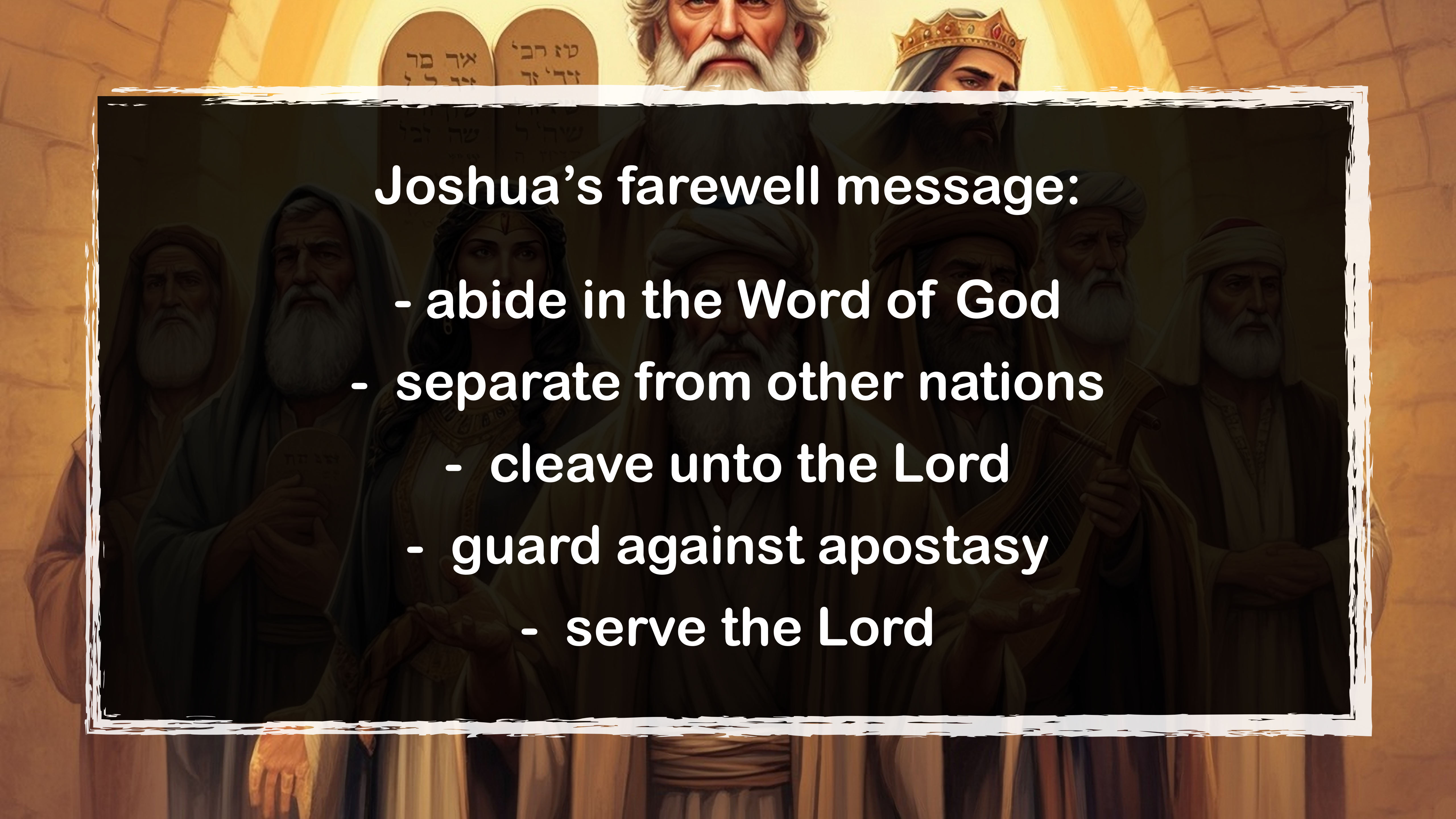

Joshua's farewell message

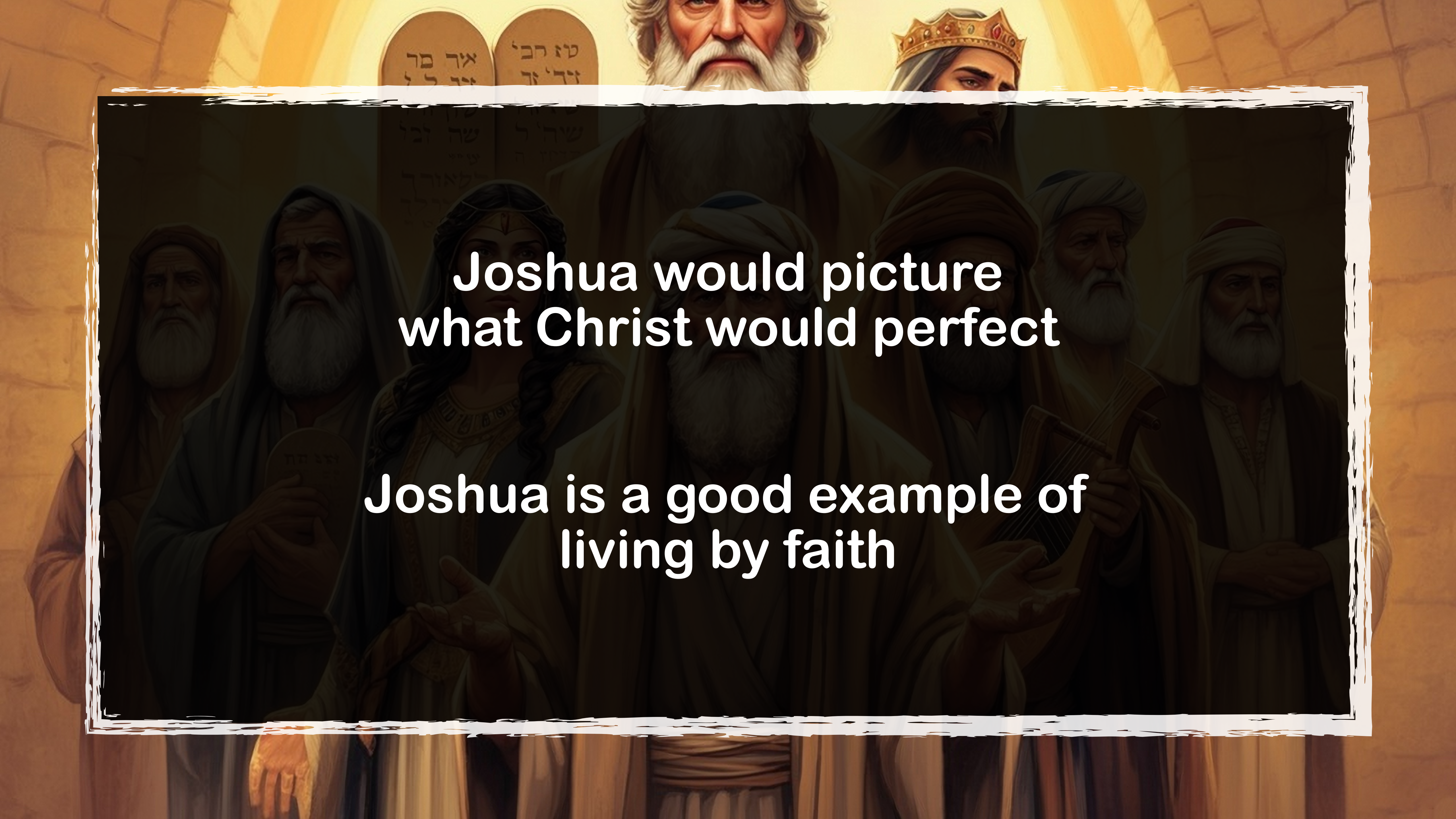


Joshua's farewell message:

 - serve the Lord

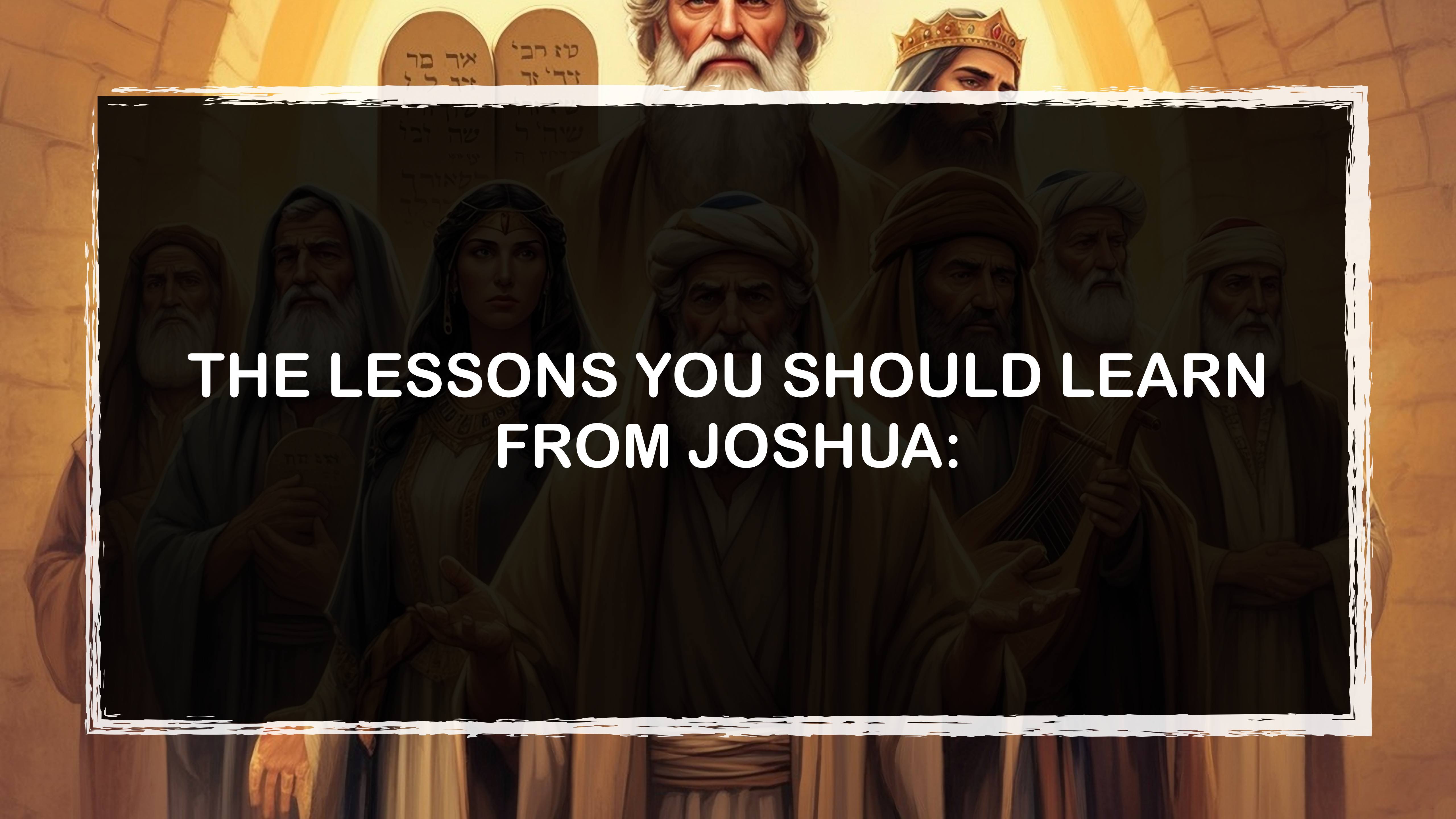
