Happy New Year, Church Family!

As we begin a new year together, I would like to propose a theme for our life and ministry at First United Methodist Church: **Doing Meaningful Ministry Together.**

Over the past year, we planted important seeds of partnership. The Rhea House, in collaboration with Reelfoot Rural Ministries, has become a powerful way we serve our food-insecure neighbors. Not only is it meeting a real and pressing need, it is also creating meaningful opportunities for Christian discipleship. Each week, more than a dozen members of our church go up to that old house to serve and to share the love of Jesus. I cannot help but believe that God is using this work to form the good Methodists of Dyersburg more fully into the image of Christ.

Another exciting partnership is just beginning. The YMCA launch is underway, and I am hopeful that many new opportunities for ministry will grow from it. In addition to the obvious ministries of camps, sports, exercise, and fellowship, I will begin facilitating small groups for YMCA members in March—offered as a kind of *spiritual exercise class*. Friends, this is classic Methodism: Small Groups meetings in spaces outside of the church building! If you are a member of both our church and the YMCA, I hope you will prayerfully consider participating in this discipleship opportunity. I also encourage you to begin imagining how we might use this partnership to further our shared calling to *Do Meaningful Ministry Together*. How might God be calling you, to orchestrate a community outreach using the YMCA resources?

And I believe God is not finished opening even more doors. A steering committee is currently discerning the launch of a respite ministry for caregivers. Our church—situated in the heart of town, where Main Street ends—has incredible facilities, generous space, and, most importantly, loving people. We have only begun to tap into the potential God has placed among us.

As we step into this new year, I invite you to pray a simple but powerful question:

“How can I join FUMC and encourage others to do meaningful ministry together?”

Grace be our guide. Big things are coming for FUMC and for our community.

2025 CONTRIBUTIONS MUST BE TURNED IN BY END OF DECEMBER

In order for your contributions to the church in 2025 to be claimed as a deduction on your 2025 tax form, they must be given in 2025. If they are mailed, they must be postmarked by December 31, 2025. Only those contributions received by the church, or if mailed postmarked by **December 31, 2025 can be credited and claimed** for tax purposes in 2025, regardless of when the check is dated.

REQUIRED MINIMUM DISTRIBUTIONS

If you are 72 years old and have an IRA, by law you must withdraw a RMD (required minimum distribution) each year. The RMD is taxable to you UNLESS you divert part or all of this distribution to a non-profit organization. This year, when you withdraw your RMD, please consider diverting all or part of your distribution to Dyersburg First United Methodist Church. It's a win/win!

MAKE SURE YOUR RECORDS AND THE CHURCH'S RECORDS MATCH

To ensure that your 2025 church contributions are deductible, please do not file your 2025 income tax return until you have received a statement of your contributions from the church. Your records and our records should match, but it is wise to wait for this year's contributions statement to be sure that the deductions you claim match the records the church has of your giving.


