Dear Dyersburg FUMC Friends and Family,

Most of you know that my precious grandmother passed away last Saturday. She was 98 with two children, three grandchildren, and six great grandchildren, all of whom were blessed enough to have known the extent of her deep love. It's impossible to count the number of things about her for which I am grateful, not the least of which is her unconditional love. But as I sit at Scarritt Bennett Center in Nashville doing the work of the Board of Ordained Ministry, I cannot help but be grateful that she was a devoted United Methodist. I probably won't get the whole story right, but, as I recall, my grandfather grew up in the Disciples of Christ Church. When they got married, the question arose of where they would make their spiritual home for themselves and for their family. I would have loved to have been privy to the conversation that led to the decision to make their home in the Methodist Church, but alas I don't know how that all went down. I just know that they ended up in the Methodist Church.

My mother and her sister both grew up at Bethany Methodist Church in Valley Station, KY where they were active in MYF. My aunt went on to college and then to Vanderbilt Divinity School. She was ordained a deacon in 1974 and elder in 1977, and even though I attended a church throughout *my* childhood that did not ordain women, I also had the opportunity to attend her church when we visited her in Kentucky and see her do this sacred work.

When I experienced my own call to ministry, I needed a denomination who would recognize that call and invite me to live it out with deep integrity. The United Methodist Church was that place. This June I will celebrate ten years of ordination as an Elder in Full Connection, and though there are countless people who influenced my journey in this calling, perhaps the one who started it all is the one whose life my family will celebrate on Saturday.


As Bishop McAlilly text me when he heard of her passing,

The third Tennessee-Western Kentucky Annual Conference will be held June 17-19, 2024, at Murfreesboro First UMC.


The Clergy Session will be online on Tuesday, June 4 at 1:00 p.m.
