Dear Dyersburg FUMC Family,

On Easter Sunday our special Communion offering will go to the Disaster Recovery Ministry provided by the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). UMCOR is a worldwide mission of the United Methodist Church that provides relief for human suffering caused by natural and human-caused disasters. UMCOR provides training, support, programing, and financial grants when disasters overwhelm a community's ability to recover alone.


So far, in 2024, UMCOR has provided both financial and on-the-ground support to survivors of flooding, landslides, forest fires, tornadoes, famine, and war around the world. If you have seen the suffering on the news or not, UMCOR is there providing a caring Christian presence in the midst of suffering.

UMCOR has been continuously supporting the disaster ministry of our Tennessee-Western Kentucky Conference since the tornadoes in Middle Tennessee that happened on March 3, 2020. Currently UMCOR is supporting our conference with training and funding to facilitate recovery efforts for floods and tornadoes in 12 counties in Tennessee and Western Kentucky. There has been initial financial support for the "Clarksville tornado" that impacted several counties in West and Middle Tennessee on December 9, 2023.

Your donation to UMCOR allows you to personally touch the lives of people who desperately need to experience hope, around the world and just around the corner. UMCOR is often characterized as "first on the scene of a disaster and the last to leave." When other agencies have left communities after disasters, UMCOR stays for the long haul. With your help, our neighbors in need will experience God's loving presence amid disasters.




Exploring General Conference Free-Self-Guided Course

TWK Annual Conference June 17 - 19, 2024


The third Tennessee-Western Kentucky Annual Conference will be held June 17-19, 2024, at Murfreesboro First UMC.
