Dear Dyersburg FUMC Family,

On Easter Sunday our special Communion offering will go to the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). UMCOR is a worldwide mission of the United Methodist Church that provides relief, response, and long-term recovery grants when disasters overwhelm a community's ability to recover on their own.

In 2023 alone UMCOR has provided both financial support and on-the-ground support to victims of flooding and landslides in California, the tornadoes that ravaged the southeast in January, and the tornado that killed more than 25 people just weeks ago in Mississippi. Internationally, UMCOR has provided relief for victims of Cyclone Freddy in southeastern Africa, and earthquakes in Turkey and Syria.

Since February 2022, UMCOR has acted on behalf of the United Methodist Church to provide aid and assistance to the people of Ukraine, including medical supplies, legal assistance, and removal of explosives.

We already know that UMCOR is, and will continue to be, present in Tipton, Haywood, McNairy, Hardin, and Hardeman counties as those communities recover from last week's storm damage.

Your donation to UMCOR allows you to personally affect the lives of people you will never meet, but who desperately need your help. UMCOR is often characterized as "first on the scene of a disaster and the last to leave." When other agencies have left communities after disasters, UMCOR stays for the long haul
