PASTORAL THOUGHTS

Good morning! My name is Nancy West, and I am a life-long member of Dyersburg First United Methodist Church. In Gibson County, my parents and grandparents were Methodists before me. I'm pretty sure my great grandparents were Methodists too. I tell you this so you will know I was born into "Methodism." It's what makes me loyal to the denomination and especially to this church.

My team is known as the E Team. "E" is for evangelism. At first, I thought I would be planning revivals and maybe going door to door to recruit people for our church. Turns out evangelism is all about hospitality! Radical Hospitality. The team furnishes the visitor bags for adults and children that you see scattered around the sanctuary. (By the way anyone can offer a visitor's bag. You do not have to be on the team!) The team reaches out personally to people who have not come in a while. We provide a family pizza party in the fall for all preschool participants (offering them a home church if they do not have one). We look for visitors every Sunday and do our best to welcome them. (By the way anyone can do that too!) We are provided with a pew pad list of visitors every week, and we attempt to reach out to them as soon as possible.

Once I did the Layman's Day address, and I challenged everyone with these simple ideas:

- 1. Everyone sitting in a 10 foot circle around you is your responsibility. Make them feel welcome.
- 2. The physical property of this church belongs to you. If you encounter a spill, paper on the floor, etc. it is your responsibility to clean it up.
- 3. You only get one chance to make a first impression. Make certain you do not miss an opportunity to make someone feel welcome.
- 4. Within seven minutes of a visitor entering the church, a decision is made to return or not. (So, before a prayer is prayed, a song is sung, or a sermon is preached, a visitor gets a feeling of being welcomed.)

My second speech about Dyersburg First United Methodist Church is, "You should try our church." We practice radical hospitality and we would love to lavish some of that on you. We have open hearts, open minds, and open doors. Please give us a try."


