Dear Dyersburg FUMC Family and Friends,

It's hard to believe that summer break is winding down and school starts in just a few weeks! But to offset that potentially heartbreaking news, I want to assure you that we have plenty of ways to get involved in these last weeks of break and first weeks of school.

On **Sunday**, **July 30**, our worship will be led by our Children's Ministry.
