As I write this, I'm sitting in my brand-new office just across from the atrium fountain. I moved here because the view of the courtyard is spectacular—and because I want to be in a space where people feel free to stop by. If my doors are open (and they usually are), please don't hesitate to come in and visit. I want to personally thank Joe Yates and Matthew Brown for their leadership in getting the space renovated.

Last Sunday, it felt like my sermon struck a nerve. I'm thankful for the Holy Spirit's work in speaking to all of our hearts.
