Dear Dyersburg FUMC Friends and Family,

It just occurred to me that you have heard most of our church leadership share their 30-second elevator speeches reflecting *why* they choose to be members of Dyersburg First United Methodist Church. But I have not yet had the chance to share *mine* with *you!*
