Dear Dyersburg First United Methodist Church Friends and Family,

This Sunday, August 13, begins a journey through Matthew's gospel as we explore and experience what it means to Walk in the Way of Jesus.

The season of the church year in which we find ourselves is called the Season after Pentecost. Sometimes you will hear it called Ordinary Time. During this long stretch of Ordinary Time between Pentecost and Advent, the gospels take us on a journey with Jesus as we hear him teach and watch him in action.

Each week we will focus on just one facet of what it means to walk in the way of Jesus.

As I mentioned several weeks ago, I encourage you to read the entirety of Matthew for yourself before we get started. And then, use the schedule below to read each Sunday's scripture *before* you come to worship.

August 13: Don't Be Afraid (Matthew 14: 22-33)

August 20: Keep Asking (Matthew 15: 21-28)

August 27: Know Who You're Following (Matthew 16: 13-20)

September 3: Take Up Your Cross (Matthew 16: 21-28)

September 10: Stay Accountable (Matthew 18: 15-20)

September 17: Forgive (Matthew 18: 21-35)

September 24: Celebrate Mercy (Matthew 20: 1-16)

Some people think the great old gospel song, "Precious Lord" was written by the famous big band leader, Tommy Dorsey. It wasn't; the author was named Thomas Andrew Dorsey, and he was the son of a Black revivalist preacher.

Thomas was born in a small town in Georgia in 1899. When he was 11, the Dorseys moved to Atlanta where Thomas began playing piano at a vaudeville theatre. Later, his family moved to Chicago where he attended classes at the College of Composition and Arranging. His stage name was "Georgia Tom" and he played piano in one of Al Capone's Chicago speakeasies and leading jazz bands.

After attending the 1921 National Baptist Convention in Chicago, Thomas began writing and publishing gospel songs. After his wife and child died suddenly, he didn't want to serve God anymore or write anymore gospel songs. A week after the funerals, Thomas sat down at a piano and had a "strange feeling" - a sudden calm and a quiet stillness. His fingers and voice fell into place with "Precious Lord take my hand, Lead me on Let me stand, ..."

Today Thomas A. Dorsey is remembered as the "Father of Gospel Music" and the author of hundreds of gospel songs including his equally famous, "Peace in the Valley."

We'll be singing "Precious Lord" this Sunday! Don't miss it!
