# Scripture Lesson

Matthew 14:22-33 CEB

Right then, Jesus made the disciples get into the boat and go ahead to the other side of the lake while he dismissed the crowds. <sup>23</sup>When he sent them away, he went up onto a mountain by himself to pray. Evening came and he was alone. <sup>24</sup>Meanwhile, the boat, fighting a strong headwind, was being battered by the waves and was already far away from land. <sup>25</sup>Very early in the morning he came to his disciples, walking on the lake. <sup>26</sup>When the disciples saw him walking on the lake, they were terrified and said, "It's a ghost!" 
