PASTORAL THOUGHTS

Dear Dyersburg FUMC Family,

Two things have become abundantly clear to me in my short time here:

- 1. We are ready to move on from the pain and loss we've experienced as a community over the last few years—but we're not quite sure how.
- 2. We want to create more meaningful and enjoyable opportunities to be together as a church family—but we're not entirely sure what that should look like.

I believe I have the next right step for us. Starting in September, we will offer Journey to Freedom small groups. These groups were incredibly effective in helping my previous church heal after their painful split. Over eight weeks, they explore themes such as grief, making changes, and discerning God's will. They offer a powerful experience of spiritual formation and community.

Heather and I will lead our first round of groups on Monday mornings and Wednesday evenings. On Wednesday nights, we'll also share a fellowship supper, along with a few other formation and/or fellowship opportunities (more on that soon). While we won't be fully returning to our old favorite, Salt and Light, this eight-week series will give us a chance to see how we might return to regular Wednesday gatherings in the future. You'll find more details in the coming weeks in the newsletter, on Facebook, and in the church bulletin.

My hope for these Journey to Freedom groups is that we will learn to build sacred and safe space for one another, speak honestly from our hearts, and—most importantly—grow in the knowledge and love of God and one another.


