This summer we signed a lease agreement with the Memphis YMCA to open a new center in our Family Life Center. Since then, it may have seemed quiet, but behind the scenes, preparations are moving forward.

In recent weeks, YMCA leadership has been on site taking measurements and planning how to retrofit our space. Most of the changes will be cosmetic—new floors, fresh paint, and a few layout adjustments. Beginning in mid-October, the FLC will close for renovations, with the goal of opening the new YMCA facility to the public in early December. Their partnership with our preschool will launch next summer.

Between now and then, our trustees, program staff, and housekeeping team will work together to clear out and re-home items currently stored in the FLC. If you have any questions about that process, please reach out to Joe Yates.

I am genuinely excited about this opportunity for our church. I've been imagining all the new people who will soon be using our facilities—neighbors who might never otherwise set foot on our campus. I'm looking forward to exercising with them, forging new connections in the community, and partnering with YMCA leadership to discover creative ways to serve and minister to Dyersburg.

There will likely be a few growing pains as we welcome a new "roommate," but with God's help, this partnership will open doors we could have never imagined. As has been our motto for years: Open Hearts, Open Doors, Open Minds. In Jesus name, let it be so!
