PASTORAL THOUGHTS

Last Sunday was perhaps my favorite Sunday in my short time here at Dyersburg First UMC. About 60 people gathered for our Sellers' Class decommissioning service. It was a beautiful mixture of emotions—heavy and joyful and everything in between. I was deeply moved by the way this church rallied around our most historic Sunday School class. I'm also grateful for the former clergy who attended in person or sent video messages to show their support. Moments like these remind me how truly special this church is to our United Methodist connection.

This Sunday we begin our Stewardship Campaign, *The Character of a Methodist*. 




WELCOME NEW BABY
