Luke 2:22-40

CEB

<sup>22</sup>When the time came for their ritual cleansing, in accordance with the Law from Moses, they brought Jesus up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. <sup>23</sup>It's written in the Law of the Lord, "Every firstborn male will be dedicated to the Lord." <sup>24</sup>They offered a sacrifice in keeping with what's stated in the Law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons. <sup>25</sup>A man named Simeon was in Jerusalem. He was righteous and devout. He eagerly anticipated the restoration of Israel, and the Holy Spirit rested on him. <sup>26</sup>The Holy Spirit revealed to him that he wouldn't die before he had seen the Lord's Christ. <sup>27</sup>Led by the Spirit, he went into the temple area. And a sword will pierce your innermost being too." <sup>36</sup>There was also a prophet, Anna the daughter of Phanuel, who belonged to the tribe of Asher. She was very old. After she married, she lived with her husband for seven years. <sup>37</sup>She was now an 84-year-old widow. She never left the temple area but worshipped God with fasting and prayer night and day. <sup>38</sup>She approached at that very moment and began to praise God and to speak about Jesus to everyone who was looking forward to the redemption of Jerusalem. <sup>39</sup>When Mary and Joseph had completed everything required by the Law of the Lord, they returned to their hometown, Nazareth in Galilee. <sup>40</sup>The child grew up and became strong. He was filled with wisdom, and God's favor was on him.
