Dear Dyersburg FUMC Friends and Family,

When it comes to hymns I have a few favorites. I love "Be Thou My Vision" and "It is Well With My Soul." I love "In the Bleak Midwinter" at Christmastime, and in the last ten years or so have been enamored with "The King of Love My Shepherd Is." But for as long as I can remember "Come Thou Fount" has had my heart. In fact, in was one of the two congregational hymns at our wedding.

That's why I almost came out of my seat when I saw the option for the "Wandering Heart" Lenten worship series.



The theme of each week corresponds to a phrase from the hymn, and the text for the week will focus on a story from the life of Peter. The creators of the worship series tell us that "In Peter, we see a person who is both steadfast and unsteady, a dear friend and a betrayer, a follower and a wanderer. In Peter, we often see ourselves. By following Peter's journey, we watch the story of Jesus unfold through the eyes of a very normal human trying to figure it all out—just like us...Ultimately, in Peter's story, we are reminded that God loves imperfect people—in fact, time and again, that's precisely who God claims and calls."

This will be a deeply moving time of worship as we prepare for the celebration of Easter and I hope that you will be part of this season of Lent in all the ways that you are available.


# **Exploring General Conference Free**-Self-Guided Course

The third Tennessee-Western Kentucky Annual Conference will be held June 17-19, 2024, at Murfreesboro First UMC.



#### Book of Acts Annual Conference Bible Study Now Available!


