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## IMPORTANT THINGS FOR YOU TO REMEMBER

- ☆ You and your child are a team. Your Cubbie cannot do the work unless you help! You, as a parent, are responsible for aiding your child in memorizing the Bible verses.
- ☆ Help your child learn one section, called a Bear Hug, each week. It is very important that your child bring his/her Handbook to club weekly and also wear the Cubbies vest (once those items are earned).
- ☆ The standard for passing sections is as follows: we give the child the first word to start him/her off, then the verse should be completed with no more than two other helps. Four-year olds must learn and recite the verse reference as well. The three-year olds do not have to learn the verse references.

# Your Cubbies Club

Cubbies is a 2-year program in AWANA Boys & Girls Club. It is designed for children no more than two 2 years away from Kindergarten. With the parent's help, the program provides preschoolers with foundational truths about God, the Bible, and Salvation.

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## CLUB DAYS

Our 2020 - 2021 Club Year begins on September 19th, meeting each Saturday at 3:00 PM, except where noted on the Club Calendar, and ending on June 12, 2021 with a Family Celebration.

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## CLUB TIME

Check-in begins at 2:45 p.m. and Check-out is 4:30 p.m.

- 1) Please **take your child to the bathroom** prior to check-in.
- 2) Please help your clubber to be on time and in club vest.
- 3) For the safety of all Cubbies in our care, children should be brought by a parent, or an adult noted on the registration, who will then remain and attend club with the child.
- 4) **At 4:15 p.m.** we will join the other age groups for our weekly awards ceremony.

Cubbies Club days generally consist of several segments: Coming-In Time (Songs, Club Motto, etc.), Puppet Show, Bible Lesson, Handbook Time, Games, and a take-home Craft.

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## AWANA HANDBOOK STANDARDS

Parents, you are the key component your child will need to pass sections. During Cubbies Club all children work through their books at the same pace. **Prior to club, it is very important that you spend some time with your child reading the Bear Hug story and memorizing the verse for that week.**

Requirements for passing sections are

- 1) At home, your child studies, learns, and recites each section with you, the parent. The parent's signature in the handbook indicates that the work has been completed.

- 2) At club, your child again recites the section to a Cubbies leader.
  - 3) **The standard for passing sections is as follows:** We give the child the first word to start him/her off, then the verse should be completed with no more than two other helps. Four-year-olds must learn and recite the verse reference as well. The three-year-olds do not have to learn the verse references.
  - 4) The leader's signature certifies that the section has been satisfactorily passed.
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## CLUB AWARDS

**Vest & Handbook** - When a child completes the Apple Acres Entrance Booklet, he/she is eligible to become a member of the Cubbies Club and receives the Awana Cubbies Vest & Handbook.

**Handbook Completion Award** - Awarded when the Apple Seed or Honey Comb Handbook is completed.

**Awards** – Patches earned for completion of Core Concepts.

**Club Attendance Awards** – Consistent club attendance is encouraged. If your child will be absent simply notify the Cubbies Director as soon as possible. Cubbies can make up missed Bear Hugs during Handbook Time anytime during the year. Cubbies receive stickers for good club attendance.

**Sunday School attendance is encouraged**, and we give fun stickers for those who do attend Sunday School.

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## CLUB SAFETY

**The safety of your clubbers is important, please read carefully.**

- **Clean, neat Vest.** For new clubbers who are working through the entrance booklet: clean, neat shirt of choice.
- **Khakis, jeans, or knee-length shorts are recommended.** Due to the types of activities during games, short-shorts, dresses, and skirts are not appropriate.
- **Appropriate shoes:** Clubbers should always wear **sturdy, closed-toed shoes that will not fall off during play (no sandals, crocs, or flip flops!)** For their safety, clubbers in inappropriate shoes or clothes will be asked to stand with their Parent to cheer for their team.
