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I would like to welcome everyone to the 2018-2019 school year. It has been wonderful to see all the returning students and to meet the new students. I am confident this is going to be a year of growth academically, socially, and emotionally for all of the students here at John Paul II Academy. I am here to support the students in all of these areas, from 4K through 8th grade. I will, once again, be delivering classroom guidance lessons twice per month in every grade. In grades 5K through 5, I will be using Second Step, a social-emotional learning program. In the junior high, grades 6-8, I will be delivering lessons on a variety of topics including friendship skills, anger management and conflict resolution, good study skills, self-control, goal setting, career counseling, and the virtues of the month. In 4K, I will be delivering lessons on kindness, teamwork, feelings identification, career exploration, and safety. Additionally, I will be offering a variety of group counseling opportunities for your children throughout the year. Invitation to groups will be based on teacher and parent recommendation, and group topics might include self-esteem, conflict resolution, anxiety, and grief to name a few. Finally, I will provide short-term individual counseling for students when the need arises.
