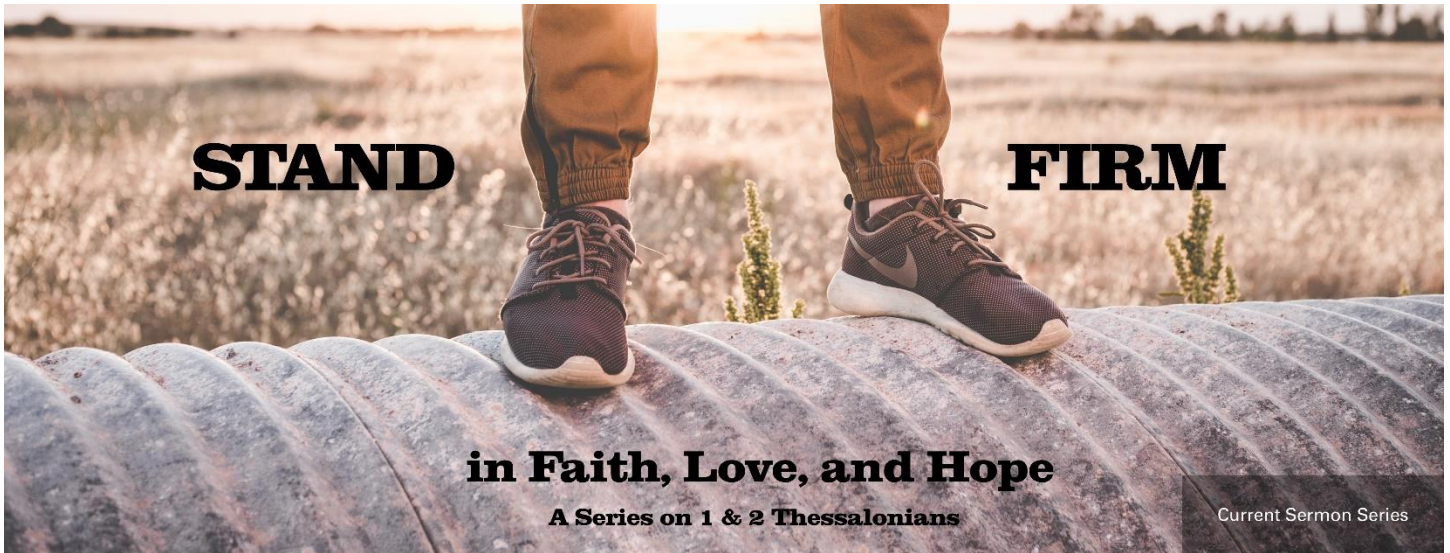

Clothing Center News

We will be open Mondays thru Thursdays 1:30-3:30 p.m. At this time, we are not accepting household items. Items accepted are clothing, shoes, underwear, socks, coats for men, women, children and infants. We will accept linens, blankets, quilts, towels, washcloths, shampoo, bath soap, deodorant, toothpaste and brushes. Masks as well as hand sanitizer will be provided for everyone. One client per household may shop but no children presently. We are only allowing 10 people in the facility at a time. We are trying to follow state and CDC guidelines for clients as well as volunteers. Questions? Please call Sandy Royer (812) 343-9726. Sunday - How to Watch/Listen to Our Services

Go to our website - centralseymour.org – and click the link for joining our services online. There you'll see four options, and you can click on the one that works best for you.

Online Church

Our services will be streamed here at 9 AM and 11 AM. This platform enables you to chat and watch the service with our church family without having to be on Facebook. There's also easy links to giving, kids materials, and an online Bible.

Facebook

We will stream the service to Facebook at 9 AM and 11 AM. You can chat with people here in the comments section. You can't pause the video or rewind the service on our Facebook stream.

YouTube

The services will also be streamed to YouTube at 9 AM and 11 AM. If you join later (like 9:30 AM), you will be able to rewind the services to the beginning and watch the whole service from the start (Click on the beginning of the red line). You will also be able to pause the service if needed and resume where you left off.

Call In

1. Our Sunday morning services start at 9 AM. At the start of the service time, dial: **669-219-2599**. It doesn't matter what type of phone you have. Any phone will work. (If that number doesn't work, try this number: **651-372-8299**)
2. It will ask you to enter a number. Enter **812 522 4211** then press #.
3. It will ask you to enter another number or press #. Don't enter a number. Just press #.
4. Wait a few minutes and you will be connected with the service.

Giving Online

To give online, go to give.centraseymour.org There you can give with your bank account information or a credit card. If you choose "Link bank account" more of your giving will go to the church because the transaction fees are lower. Thanks for continuing to give to God through the ministry of the church.
