Why serve in the KITCHEN?

The Coffee Bar provides an atmosphere of hospitality and connection. A yummy snack and coffee lead to lingering and connection. If you enjoy being in the kitchen or providing a clean and organized area; this is for you!

Your role in the KITCHEN:

- First Shift Role: Set up coffee and other refreshments. Bake cookies for all services. Ensure that food areas remain clean and attractive throughout your shift when time allows.
- Second Shift Role: Clean up kitchen, coffee bar and food areas and reset areas so they are ready for the following week.

Expectations:

- Position at the Marion Campus only
- Serve at the minimum of 2 times a month for 90 days.
- Serve one hour, worship the other.
- Find your own replacement, when needed, via the volunteer schedule on RiverConnect.
- Engage in team huddle prior to service(s).
- Inform team leader of any concerns.
- First Shift: Arrive at 8:00am and stay until relieved at the start of second service
- Second Shift: Arrive at 10:00 and is relieved after service or when all areas are cleaned and reset.

Next steps:

- Jump on The River app or website and fill out the SAY YES form under "Next Steps" or let us know by filling out a communication card.
- Not sure where you want to serve? The SAY YES form has all available serving opportunities for your campus.
- Once you let us know, you will be contacted by the team leader or volunteer coordinator to review scheduling, training and procedures.
- If this seems like a good ministry fit, you will shadow a volunteer for at least one Sunday before serving a shift on your own.

Notes:

You'll make some new friends but, unfortunately, some people may not appreciate all your hard work. Don't take it personally. Continue to serve lovingly and cheerfully!

Serving is a major part of your spiritual growth and health. We can't wait for you to JUMP IN and be a part of helping people become fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ!
