Why be a SMALL GROUP ASSISTANT?

Helping children see God for who He is and see themselves the way God sees them can be a growth opportunity not only for the children, but you too! They learn from us connecting them to a better story for their life by giving and showing them authentic faith in Jesus. We learn to remember a childlike faith that keeps us out of doubt and into a stronger faith life for ourselves.

Your role as a SMALL GROUP ASSISTANT:

- Model Christ's love so they may see Jesus in you
- Get to know them, their stories, their lives and their struggles
- Assist the teacher in any preparation that is needed
- Greet and interact with the children as they arrive and during worship and the large group lesson
- Redirect any disruptive or inattentive children
- Help the teacher implement routines, structure and a safe environment
- Encourage memorization of the monthly memory verse and the use of the weekly take home activities

Expectations:

- Serve every week or every other week for 90 days
- Be committed to The River Church and our values
- Find your own replacement, when needed, via approved contact list
- Arrival time: 8:30
 - Engage in team huddle at 8:30
 - Serve one hour, Worship the other
- Review names of new families you met and connect with them on following Sunday's

Next steps:

- Discuss your interest with the Volunteer Coordinator, Bridget Lamb by emailing her at bridget@theriver.cc or filling out a communication card.
- Complete the Children's Ministry Application including a background check
- If this seems like a good ministry fit, you will receive training and procedures from a Kids Kreek Leader and shadow a volunteer for at least one Sunday.
