Why be a PRESCHOOL ASSISTANT?

Preschoolers are sponges ready to soak up everything we teach them. They are learning to sit in a controlled setting for a longer period of time and eager to learn new things. We want our preschoolers to LEARN about Jesus and build a foundation on truth with minimal free play. At this age they begin to see the world outside of their selves. This leaves us ample opportunity to engage with them to create a firm foundation of faith that will stick as they grow.

Your role as a PRESCHOOL ASSISTANT:

- Love them, play with them, get to know them and their families
- Help the teacher implement routines, structure and a safe environment
- Assist the teacher in any preparation that is needed
- Work alongside the teacher interacting during the activity, bible story, snack, and prayer time
- Redirect any disruptive or inattentive children
- Help and encourage the preschoolers to learn the memory verse for the month
- Help with clean up

Expectations:

- Be committed to The River Church and our values.
- Serving commitment:
MARION CAMPUS: Serve every week or every other week for 90 days. Serve one hour, worship the other.
CHESTERTON CAMPUS: Serve 1-2 times monthly for 90 days.
- Engage in team huddle prior to service(s).
- Find your own replacement, when needed, via the volunteer schedule on RiverConnect.

Next steps:

- If this seems like a good ministry fit, you will receive training and procedures from a Kids Kreek Leader and shadow a volunteer for at least one Sunday.

- Interested in leading a class? Meet with the Children's Director after serving in this role for 90 days.
