GETTING STARTED:

- 1) Share an experience (like BGorman's meeting the huge wrestler), where you felt fear, respect and awe all at the same time?
- 2) Share a "YES" you have made that you have never regretted making, (other than your marriage & or accepting Jesus).

MESSAGE BIG IDEA: Saying yes to God and to others is a matter of faith and trust but that does not mean that what we are being asked to do will always be something enjoyable.

MAIN SCRIPTURE: Isaiah 6

DISCUSSION

3) Uzziah was described as a 'good' king, (one who draws others closer to God). Should that be criteria today as to what a 'good' president, governor etc is?

4) How would you draw a picture today of how big God is (like Isaiah tried to draw for his day)?

5) How does the message God wanted Isaiah to share (vs 9-13) sit with your concept of God today?

6) What are some reasons we can be hesitant to say yes to God?

DIG DEEPER

7) Read Luke 9:23-25 What does it mean to take up one's cross? How does taking up our cross help us say "yes" to God when He asks us to be uncomfortable?

8) How do we know that it is actually God asking us to do something or someone manipulating us?

9) What would you say to a new Christian friend who is surprised that things are going as smoothly as they thought they should after they said "yes" to God?

BRING IT HOME

10) What is God asking us to do when he invites us to join Him with a "yes" in His work?

11) What are a couple things we could do to help inspire a more worshipful awe of God (like Isaiah experienced) in our private devotions and or corporate worship?

ASK FOR GOD'S HELP

12) Describe an experience where you said "yes" to God's leading that was hard to do or you resisted?

13) Share with God one thing right now in your life that you are you are hesitating saying "yes" to?
