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## GETTING STARTED:

- 1) What is one of the most dangerous things you have ever attempted?
- 2) What is one of the most dangerous prayers that you have ever prayed?

## MESSAGE BIG IDEA: Most Dangerous Prayer

MAIN SCRIPTURE: Psalms 139:23-24; Eph. 3:14-21

## DISCUSSION

- 1) Which do you find more aligned with God: your mind, heart, or actions? Why do you think that is?
- 2) Can you do the "will of God" if your heart is not in it? Explain.
- 3) Why are we prone to use our own efforts to transform areas that we are weak?
- 4) What was David asking God to specifically do that is so "dangerous"? (Psalms 139:23-24)
- 5) Which is the most dangerous for YOU to pray: "Search me?" "Test me?" "Know my anxious thoughts?"

## DIG DEEPER (Other scriptures?)

- 1) Read Mark 12:28-30. How specifically, does one love God with all their heart, soul, and mind?
- 2) Read Ephesians 3:19. How does love surpass knowledge?
- 3) Read Romans 7:15-20. How is Paul separating actions from knowledge? From desire?

## BRING IT HOME

- 1) What are some ways that you have changed that are clearly because of God's power within you?
- 2) What issues do you struggle with that require more than willpower to resolve?

## ASK FOR GOD'S HELP

- 1) To rely more on Him and less on yourself.
- 2) That we may be filled with the fullness of God.
