Throughout this series, we'll be reminded that the Christian life isn't ultimately about discovering something new, but about growing deeper into the riches of what God has already revealed in His Son. In a world full of distractions, competing loyalties, and endless demands for our attention, Colossians calls us to fix our eyes on Christ and to build our lives upon Him.

I hope you'll join us throughout the month of July as we consider the greatness of Christ and what it means to follow Him faithfully in every area of life.

Thank you all for your service and may God bless you!

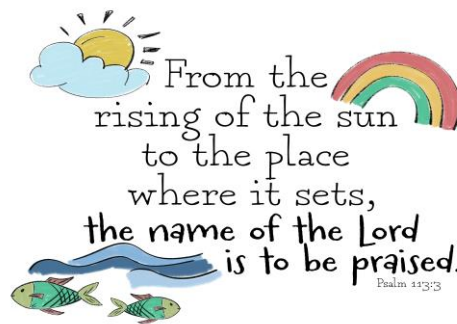
