PERSONALLY FROM THE PASTOR

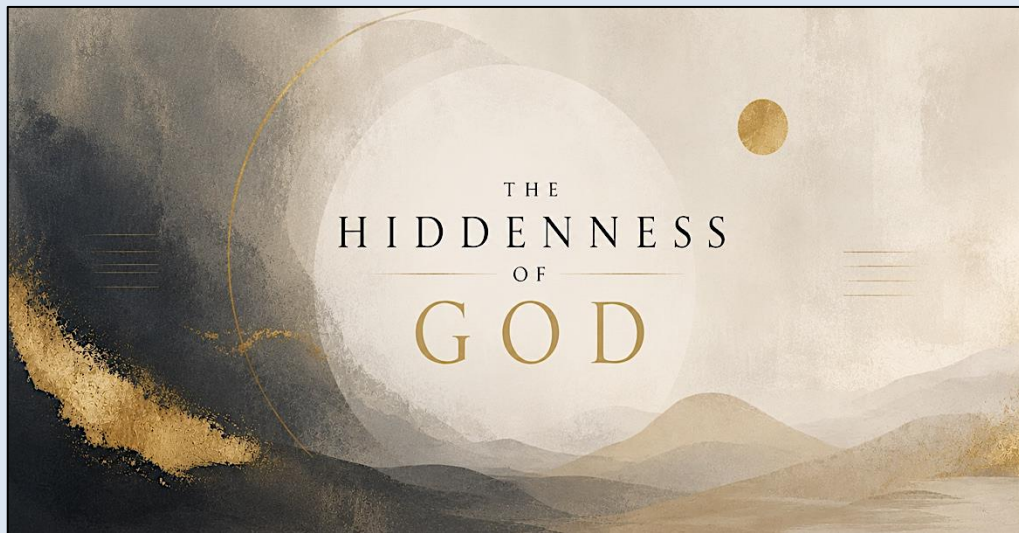
To My Church Family,
