LIGHTING THE SECOND ADVENT CANDLE – PEACE

A member of our Confirmation class

1<sup>st</sup> person: Advent means "coming" and in this season we prepare for the coming of Christ. One

of the ways we can celebrate Advent is by lighting candles on an Advent Wreath. It reminds us of the gifts Christ brings to the world. Last Sunday, we lit the first candle on our Advent Wreath, the candle of hope. Let us light it again, remembering that the light of hope shines for us in the darkness.

(The purple Hope Candle is lit.)

2<sup>nd</sup> person: Peace is one of God's gifts to us. John the Baptist was a prophet calling the people

of Israel to repent, to find peace with God. May we, by our actions, help to prepare

the way for the coming of Peace.

We light this second candle to remind us that Jesus is the Prince of Peace. His light helps us find ways to share God's peace with others.

(The purple Peace Candle is lit.)

3<sup>rd</sup> person: The Prayer of St. Francis asks God to help us be peacemakers.

Let us pray together:

Lord, make us instruments of Your peace. Where there is hatred, let us sow love; where there is injury, pardon; where there is doubt, faith; where there is despair, hope; where there is sadness, joy; and where there is darkness, light. Grant that we may not seek so much to be consoled as to console, to be understood as to understand, to be loved as to love. For it is in giving that we receive, in pardoning that we are pardoned, and in dying that we are born to eternal life. Amen.
