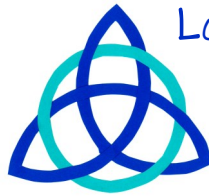

From the Pastor's Desk



The other day I came across a quote that brought a smile to my face, yet at the same time challenged me to take an honest look at myself. The quote comes from Albert Einstein and goes like this: *"Only two things are infinite, the universe and human stupidity, and I'm not sure about the former."* The quote brought a smile because just as God's love is new every morning, so is my awareness of my folly.

At this year's National Gathering, I sat in on a *break-out* session that focused on the importance of churches being outward focused. We spent over 90 minutes discussing the question, *"Why does our church exist?"* Although the majority of us looked to Matthew 28:19-20 as our biblical mandate, *"Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, ²⁰and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you"*, we concluded that most churches are more inward focused than outward focused. Most churches, by their actions and budgets, care more about the people inside their walls than the people outside of their walls. I came back from our National Gathering even more energized, knowing that this Spring a team of people at Trinity will be engaging in an outward focused program called Alpha.

What is Alpha? Alpha is an evangelistic tool that helps people to discover and develop a relationship with Jesus. Alpha helps create a space for honest conversations around some of life's biggest questions. It is designed to provide guests an opportunity to connect with one another, while providing the opportunity to share thoughts, ideas, and opinions in a safe and caring environment. Alpha helps bring people together while providing the chance to encounter Jesus. Alpha holds firmly to the biblical mandate to GO!

This is not a ministry for people inside the church but a ministry that uses the God-given gifts of believers in the church to reach out to those outside of The church. Our hope is to start Alpha on Sunday March 16th. This will be a time where we will gather for a meal, followed by a short video exploring issues of life and faith. I ask that you keep this ministry in your prayers, and if you know of people outside the church that would benefit from this special outreach please let me know.

Peace in the Spotlight

The word *turmoil* bolts across the brainwaves immediately as one thinks about our immediate introduction to the New Year 2025: devastating fires, airplane collisions, mudslides, distresses over international borders, influenza, bird flu, resurgence of Covid, and let's not even talk about the soaring price of eggs.

Should someone dare to mention the word *peace*, its meaning smacks of being gutted of all significance. Ever since Eden it appears to have worn a cloak of elusiveness that few people, if any, have been able to toss aside on their own. Yet it is a genuine quality, even a quest, that is purportedly sought by nation after nation. To look at the front page of any newspaper, it seems that all of society has regularly missed the mark on this target.

Is this something that God intended us to avoid or be deprived of? Absolutely not. But looking for an answer outside of God's intentions is a fruitless search. In the hands of mankind, Peace is such a fragile thing, but in God's hands it is a thing of unparalleled strength. Where then does God begin to nourish, exercise and grow this innate quality? If you are beginning to squirm a bit, you're on to something. Yes, it begins within you and within me.

Let us be very clear about the difficulty of accessing this amazing quality. Believers in the Lord Jesus Christ are *urged* to make it a goal in their lives. At least two times in letters that the Apostle Peter wrote to us, he admonished us to, "turn from evil and do good, to seek peace and *pursue* it, ...to *make every effort* – be eager, diligent—to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with Him." Peter further explains that this requires perseverance and patience.

The author of the book of Hebrews places a marvelous capstone on this very subject as he concludes, "May the *God of peace*, ...equip you with everything good for doing His will, and may he work in us what is pleasing to Him, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."
