

### From the Pastor's Desk

### Stewardship and Giving to God's Work

When we hear the word stewardship, our minds often go straight to money. But in Scripture, stewardship is much bigger than that. A steward is someone entrusted with the care of something that belongs to another. Everything we have—our time, talents, treasure, even the breath in our lungs—belongs first to God. We are not owners but caretakers, called to manage His gifts faithfully.

#### **God Owns It All**

Psalm 24:1 declares, "The earth is the Lord's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it." From the food on our tables to the opportunities before us, all comes from the Lord's hand. When we give back to God, we are not losing what is ours; we are returning what already belongs to Him.

#### Why We Give

Giving is an act of worship. Just as singing praises lifts our hearts to God, so does generous giving. It is also an act of trust. When we release part of what we have, we are declaring, "Lord, I believe You will continue to provide." Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians 9:7, "Each one must give as he has decided in his heart, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver."

### **True Stewardship Goes Beyond Money**

True stewardship is not just about what we put in the offering plate. It includes how we use our time in service, how we offer our skills for the good of others, and how we open our homes and hearts in hospitality. Every act of service, no matter how small, can be an offering to God.

### The Impact of Giving

When we give faithfully, God's work expands. Your giving supports the ministries that touch the lives of others and builds relationships which open opportunities for people to deepen their faith. Your giving helps feed the hungry and provide the necessities of life for those in need. Your giving, whether large or small, becomes part of God's kingdom story. Jesus multiplied five loaves and two fish to feed thousands; He can take what we offer and accomplish far more than we can imagine.

### From the Pastor's Desk (cont.)

#### A Heart of Gratitude

Stewardship is ultimately about gratitude. We give not out of guilt, but out of joy—because we have already received so much from our Lord. The cross of Christ reminds us that God gave His very best: His Son for our salvation. Our giving is simply a reflection of His generosity.

### A Prayerful Response



### **Thirty Hours**

Does ever a day go by that we do not measure, tabulate, or calculate something? Carving things from exotic woods brings me a ton of pleasure. But before putting the knife to a piece of wood, there are calculations to be determined and sketches to be made. Once the preliminaries are complete, the work begins and much patience is required. Heaps of wood chips begin to spread over the workshop floor. Then many hours of time whiz by till the product is finished – often involving days, weeks, and frequently, months. When someone else assesses the finished piece, invariably, the question arises, "How long did it take you to do that?" My usual tired reply is always, "Thirty hours." Of course it's a lie. I might as well have been asked how many wood chips hit the floor before the project was finished. May sound ridiculous, but Someone knows the count.

Our Master, the Lord Jesus, was a stickler for detail when He said, "Even the hairs of your head are numbered." And He didn't even qualify that statement with "presuming you have any!" The question above might possibly beg another question: How many heartbeats will you and I be given in our respective lifetimes? Someone knows.

In 1990 the first Hubble Telescope was launched into space. It was a mind-blowing experience to see images of the universe covered with millions of stars and countless galaxies never before imagined. More recently, an even larger 'eye in the sky', the James Webb Space Telescope, purports a range of vision and discovery that outstrips the Hubble. What kind of mind could possibly comprehend the number of stars in that enormous expanse? Someone knows, one Who "determines the number of stars and calls them each by name!"

One day, if I feel bold enough to face our Creator and ask the question, "How long did it take You to create the universe?", without hesitation, and perhaps accompanied by a wink, He might just respond with, "Thirty hours!...but it's a work in progress...just like you!"
