Satan doesn't stop coming after us! He'll remind you of what you've lost through the years, he'll remind you of what you're missing out on, he'll ring in your ears the mean words you've heard and remind you of the memories that hurt, and he'll do whatever he can to get you isolated, lonely, and too sad to pray.

James 4:7 says, "Submit yourselves then to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you!"

Resist him, friend! He's having a party of joy when he's got you lonely or when he convinces you not to worship, or pray, or call a friend, or reach out to a loved one. He's so happy when we get too busy or stressed or lonely or bored to shine some of Jesus' light on the people around us. Be a heart-breaker: Break the heart of the devil! "I won't give in to your lies and deception and depression, devil! Get behind me Satan! Be gone – I'm a child of the King, a child of God the Father, filled with the Spirit of Christ – be gone in the strong name of Jesus!"

A scholar who studied early Methodists called his book, Organizing to Beat the Devil: Methodists and the Making of America. Let's organize our days and hours to keep our eyes on Jesus, His love and joy and strength, and organize our time and relationships to keep our connection with the Lord AND other believers strong. The devil's coming for you, but he's gonna be disappointed!


