A Note from Pastor Nathan



Have you ever seen an angel, literally? As in, one from the other dimension called 'heaven'? If so, please give me a call because I'd love to hear about that! One reputable friend told me when he saw an angel it was MASSIVE and a bit terrifying, which certainly aligns with the way in the Bible they always start a conversation with, "Fear not!"

Have you ever seen Jesus, literally, in bodily form? We just celebrated Easter with 'Resurrection Sunday,' and most of us believe in the Resurrection of Jesus because of eyewitnesses who were not us...but once in a while I've talked with someone who says that Jesus has really appeared to them quite directly. One such person said, "Jesus told me to tell you that He has big and wonderful plans for you," to which I wanted to say, "Um, you tell Jesus I prefer He tell me directly himself" – but fearing blasphemy, I did not! Again, these have been very reputable people and for them it has made a deep impression on their lives and boosted their faith.

Have you ever seen the Holy Spirit? Now we're getting into some really bizarre territory, because Jesus said it was better for humans for him to go away into the dimension of heaven than to stay with us directly, in the flesh (John 16:7 -- "But I tell you the truth, it is better for you that I go away. If Jesus were still on Earth bodily, He would be constantly mobbed by crowds of millions, while billions on other parts of the earth would simultaneously yearn with intense longing for the time when they could mob him and hug him and hear his words of help and affirmation. But now, you have that availability this very moment as you read this, and I have that availability at this very same moment though I may be miles away.

So may we both, now, and all the time, delight in taking advantage of that unending availability of God's presence and guidance. Come Holy Spirit, lead us into the loving grace of Jesus...now...at this moment when others around the world are enjoying this exact same experience, together.


