As the brothers talked about their own love and appreciation for those two, I could barely hold myself together. (Those tender hearts in those boys were in there SOMEWHERE – Jennifer and I knew it!!! Hahaha!)

Weddings SHOULD be emotional, because marriage is the relationship that God has chosen to be the picture of the love that He has toward us, the followers of Jesus. In Revelation, we are called the "bride" of Christ, who is being

husbands as you do to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife as Christ is the head of the church, his body, of which he is the Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit to their husbands in everything. [Oh but every domineering husband has to keep on reading the next verses!] Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word, and to present her to himself as a radiant church, without stain or wrinkle or any other blemish, but holy and blameless. In this same way, husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. After all, no one ever hated their own body, but they feed and care for their body, just as Christ does the church—for we are members of his body."

Now remember, the guy who God used to write those words was *single*, as was Jesus – so the point isn't that every person needs to be married! What I want ALL of us to remember is that you are the recipient of such love from God that Jesus has gone to the furthest length to do what it takes to wash you clean of brokenness and sin so you can be holy, blameless, and spotless. "Jesus, we accept with passionate, grateful hearts your loving action of death, resurrection, cleansing, and healing! Thank you! Help us to share it with the world!! Amen."

### **Bonnie Kubala**

I was born in Erie PA to Harold and Naomi Lingenfelter. I have one brother twelve years older than me named David. When I was four, we moved to Shelby Ohio where I grew up. Life in small town Shelby was good. We were a church family. Every Sunday was the same. We attended Shelby First United Methodist Church, Sunday school then youth group in the evening. My closest friends also attended that church where we were all confirmed together.

In high school, I was active in sports, music and other clubs. I played volleyball and softball during school. In the summer I swam and played tennis. I was in ski club and Bi Phy Chem club. God introduced me to Jim Kubala three years later, on an online dating site. Jim was a customer service manager with OSU hospital when I met him. Now, almost fifteen years later, we are both retired. Between us, we have five children and five grandchildren.

My hobbies are reading, music, crocheting and gardening. Jim enjoys golfing and he recently has taken up the hobby of model railroads.

We moved to Marysville in March of 2020, right as COVID was ramping up. We knew we wanted to find a church that met our needs. I grew up Methodist, so I was most familiar with this denomination. I wanted to find a church with a bell choir and a contemporary service. In the fall, 2020 we started attending Marysville United Methodist Church. We were very supportive of the decision to disaffiliate from the UMC to Global Methodist. This was where we are supposed to be, in Marysville and Cornerstone Global Methodist Church.

So far at Cornerstone I play in the bell choir, crochet for Cornerstone Crocheters and serve on Leadership Team and the church Finance Team. I also love Pastor Peggy's Faith Sistas Bible Study. When we found Cornerstone church, I felt that it
