- July Financial Reports presented
  - Balance sheet remains strong even with disaffiliation costs and loss of some pledges through the disaffiliation process.
  - Disaffiliation loan is now under \$100 K (\$93,684.15)
  - Budget
    - Giving favorable by \$7,300
    - Expenses favorable by 4% (YTD target 58%, current YTD 54%)
  - Finance Sub Team asked staff to share whether they intended to use full budget.

- Tom McCarthy of McCarthy and Cox attended August Finance Sub Team meeting and urged us to develop and implement an Investment Policy. He provided options to rebalance portfolio and look at possibly diversifying investments through a sweep. He also recommended having two to three individuals monitor the investment accounts.
- Action Items: Dick McConnell moved to name Sharon Kelley as Interim Chair for the Finance Sub Team due to current Chair's ongoing health concerns; Nancy Bowman seconded the motion, the motion passed with nine ayes, zero opposed and one abstention.
