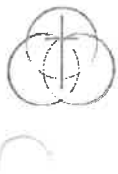
Ministry Recommendations & Reports

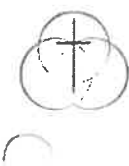

Instructions

What is the purpose of this form? The Internal Revenue Code Section 107 has a provision that allows ministers of the Gospel to exclude from their reportable income some costs of living in a parsonage or their own home. The church uses the Parsonage or Housing Allowance Exclusion form.

Does this cost the church anything? No. The pastor's salary is not increased or decreased as a result of the resolution. It merely designates a portion of the pastor's salary as being excluded from the amount of compensation the church reports to the IRS on the pastor's W-2.

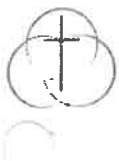
When should this form be filled out? At least annually and whenever there is a change in pastors. It must be done before the pastor incurs the expenses. The exclusion cannot be made retroactive.

How much should the exclusion be? The pastor establishes the amount in consultation with the Pastor/Parish Relations Committee. For a church-owned parsonage, the amount should not exceed the fair rental value of the parsonage or house. A rule of thumb for the annual "fair rental value" is to take 5% - 8% of the market value of the parsonage or house. If a housing allowance is paid to the pastor, the exclusion should include the amount of the allowance as well as other anticipated expenses.

What is included in the exclusion? Any expenses the pastor may incur in living in the parsonage or home. The following is a partial listing and not meant to be inclusive of all items that may be excluded.

1. Rent or principal payments, cost of buying a home, and down payments, if paid by the pastor.
 2. Real estate taxes and mortgage interest for the home, if paid by the pastor.
 3. Insurance on a home, if paid by the pastor.
 4. Improvements, repairs, and upkeep of the home and/or contents. New roof, room addition, carpet, garage, etc.
 5. Furnishings and appliances: dishwasher, vacuum sweeper, TV, VCR, DVD, piano, computer for personal use, washer, dryer, sewing machine, cookware, dishes etc.
 6. Decorator items: drapes, throw rugs, pictures, knick-knacks, painting, wallpapering, bedspreads, sheets, towels, etc.
 7. Utilities: heat, electric, cable TV, etc. (ONLY IF PAID BY THE PASTOR)
 8. Misc: anything that maintains the home and its contents that you have not included in repairs or decorator items: cleaning supplies for the home, brooms, light bulbs, expense to run the lawnmower, landscaping tools etc.
- These may be excluded even if they become the pastor's personal property, as long as they are paid from money received as salary. Major appliances such as refrigerators and ranges purchased with church funds may not be excluded.

DO NOT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: Maid (or any labor hired for maintenance such as lawn care), groceries, personal toiletries, CD's etc. What if I have other questions? Speak with the Presiding Elder or the Conference Treasurer's office.

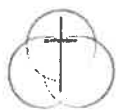

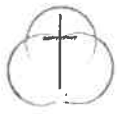

The following resolution was duly adopted by the Administrative Board/Church Council/Leadership Team (or Charge Conference) of the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church at a meeting held on 11/5/2023.

Under Internal Revenue Code Section 62(a)(2)(A) gross income does not include reimbursed business expenses or adequately accounted business expense allowances for employees. Internal Revenue Service Regulation 1.162-17(b) provides that an employee need not report on their tax return expenses paid or incurred by them solely for the benefit of their employer, for which they are required to account and do account to their employer, and which are charged directly or indirectly to the employer. Further, I.R.S. Regulation 1.274-5(e)(4) provides that an adequate accounting means the submission to the employer of an account book, diary, statement of expense, or similar record maintained by the employee in which the information (as to each element of expenditure amount, time and place, business purpose, and business relationship) is recorded at or near the time of the expenditure, together with supporting documentary evidence, in a manner that conforms to all the adequate records requirements as set forth in the regulations.

Therefore, the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church hereby establishes an accountable reimbursement policy pursuant to I.R.S. Regulations upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Expenses deemed ordinary and necessary shall be made solely for the benefit of the church and shall be paid directly, whenever possible by the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church, or indirectly and reimbursed to the person or entity who does pay the expense. Ordinary expenses include, but are not limited to: automobiles, office supplies, postage, computer supplies, books, subscriptions, professional dues, vestments, continuing education, lodging and meals while traveling and entertainment related to church business.
2. The church must be given an adequate accounting of the expense, which means that there shall be submitted a statement of expense, account book diary, or other similar record showing the amount, date, place, business purpose, and business relationship involved. Appropriate documents, cash receipts, canceled checks, credit card sales slips, and contemporaneous records for those non-receipt expenses less than \$25.00 must be attached to a monthly expense report. Both the minister/staff person and the church shall retain copies of the documentary evidence and expense report. Voucher information need not include data that would violate pastoral confidences.
3. Reimbursements or advances must be paid out of budgeted church funds and not by reducing the compensation of a minister/staff person. Budgeted amounts not spent must not be paid as a salary bonus or other personal compensation in any fiscal year. If such payments are made, the entire amount of the accountable reimbursement policy account will be taxable income to the pastor/staff person.
4. The church may pay amounts in advance of the minister/staff person's actual expenditure on either an as needed basis or by standard monthly expense allowance. However, an adequate accounting of the advances by expense report must be made in the month following an expenditure. Any excess advance must be returned to the church before additional needed or allowance amounts are provided to the minister/staff person.

5. It is understood by the various parties that all elements of this resolution must be carefully followed to prevent the church salary-paying unit from being required by regulation to list total payments for the following items on I.R.S. Does this cost the church anything? No. The pastor's salary is not increased or decreased as a result of the resolution. It merely designates a portion of the pastor's salary as being excluded from the amount of compensation the church reports to the IRS on the pastor's W-2.

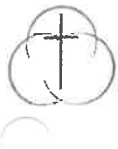
When should this form be filled out? At least annually and whenever there is a change in pastors. It must be done before the pastor incurs the expenses. The exclusion cannot be made retroactive.

How much should the exclusion be? The pastor establishes the amount in consultation with the Pastor/Parish Relations Committee. For a church-owned parsonage, the amount should not exceed the fair rental value of the parsonage or house. A rule of thumb for the annual "fair rental value" is to take 5% - 8% of the market value of the parsonage or house. If a housing allowance is paid to the pastor, the exclusion should include the amount of the allowance as well as other anticipated expenses.

What is included in the exclusion? Any expenses the pastor may incur in living in the parsonage or home. The following is a partial listing and not meant to be inclusive of all items that may be excluded.

1. Rent or principal payments, cost of buying a home, and down payments, if paid by the pastor.
 2. Real estate taxes and mortgage interest for the home, if paid by the pastor.
 3. Insurance on a home, if paid by the pastor.
 4. Improvements, repairs, and upkeep of the home and/or contents. New roof, room addition, carpet, garage, etc.
 5. Furnishings and appliances: dishwasher, vacuum sweeper, TV, VCR, DVD, piano, computer for personal use, washer, dryer, sewing machine, cookware, dishes etc.
 6. Decorator items: drapes, throw rugs, pictures, knick-knacks, painting, wallpapering, bedspreads, sheets, towels, etc.
 7. Utilities: heat, electric, cable TV, etc. (ONLY IF PAID BY THE PASTOR)
 8. Misc: anything that maintains the home and its contents that you have not included in repairs or decorator items: cleaning supplies for the home, brooms, light bulbs, expense to run the lawnmower, landscaping tools etc.
- These may be excluded even if they become the pastor's personal property, as long as they are paid from money received as salary. Major appliances such as refrigerators and ranges purchased with church funds may not be excluded.

DO NOT INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING: Maid (or any labor hired for maintenance such as lawn care), groceries, personal toiletries, CD's etc. What if I have other questions? Speak with the Presiding Elder or the Conference Treasurer's office.

WHEREAS the cost of providing the parsonage or housing allowance with utilities and/or furnishings may be excluded from gross income the Internal Revenue revised rule 599,359-51-52 and Section 107;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church will designate \$ 25,000 of the pastor's salary as parsonage/housing allowance. This amount is to be excluded from the reported taxable income.

This resolution is effective during calendar year for 2024.

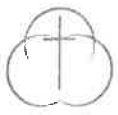

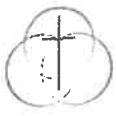

2024 Accountable Reimbursement Policy

The following resolution was duly adopted by the Administrative Board/Church Council/Leadership Team (or Charge Conference) of the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church at a meeting held on 11/5/2023.

Under Internal Revenue Code Section 62(a)(2)(A) gross income does not include reimbursed business expenses or adequately accounted business expense allowances for employees. Internal Revenue Service Regulation 1.162-17(b) provides that an employee need not report on their tax return expenses paid or incurred by them solely for the benefit of their employer, for which they are required to account and do account to their employer, and which are charged directly or indirectly to the employer. Further, I.R.S. Regulation 1.274-5(e)(4) provides that an adequate accounting means the submission to the employer of an account book, diary, statement of expense, or similar record maintained by the employee in which the information (as to each element of expenditure amount, time and place, business purpose, and business relationship) is recorded at or near the time of the expenditure, together with supporting documentary evidence, in a manner that conforms to all the adequate records requirements as set forth in the regulations.

Therefore, the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church hereby establishes an accountable reimbursement policy pursuant to I.R.S. Regulations upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Expenses deemed ordinary and necessary shall be made solely for the benefit of the church and shall be paid directly, whenever possible by the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church, or indirectly and reimbursed to the person or entity who does pay the expense. Ordinary expenses include, but are not limited to: automobiles, office supplies, postage, computer supplies, books, subscriptions, professional dues, vestments, continuing education, lodging and meals while traveling and entertainment related to church business.
2. The church must be given an adequate accounting of the expense, which means that there shall be submitted a statement of expense, account book diary, or other similar record showing the amount, date, place, business purpose, and business relationship involved. Appropriate documents, cash receipts, canceled checks, credit card sales slips, and contemporaneous records for those non-receipt expenses less than \$25.00 must be attached to a monthly expense report. Both the minister/staff person and the church shall retain copies of the documentary evidence and expense report. Voucher information need not include data that would violate pastoral confidences.
3. Reimbursements or advances must be paid out of budgeted church funds and not by reducing the compensation of a minister/staff person. Budgeted amounts not spent must not be paid as a salary bonus or other personal compensation in any fiscal year. If such payments are made, the entire amount of the accountable reimbursement policy account will be taxable income to the pastor/staff person.
4. The church may pay amounts in advance of the minister/staff person's actual expenditure on either an as needed basis or by standard monthly expense allowance. However, an adequate accounting of the advances by expense report must be made in the month following an expenditure. Any excess advance must be returned to the church before additional needed or allowance amounts are provided to the minister/staff person.

5. It is understood by the various parties that all elements of this resolution must be carefully followed to prevent the church salary-paying unit from being required by regulation to list total payments for the following items on I.R.S. W-2 as includible compensation. The primary responsibility of expense reporting is the minister/staff person to the church payroll person.
6. The Staff/Parish or Pastor/Parish Relations Committee (SP/PPRC) is responsible for approving vouchers submitted by the pastor. The local church treasurer is responsible for paying approved vouchers.
7. By previous or concurrent resolution, duly adopted by the Administrative Board/Church Council/Leadership Team (or Charge Conference) of the Cornerstone - Marysville, Ohio Global Methodist Church at a meeting held on 11/5/2023, the following ordinary and necessary expenses as suggested for the employment needs of the minister/staff person, are included in this accountable reimbursement policy from Jan 1, 2024 to Dec 31, 2024.

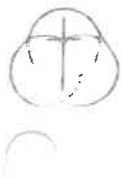

2023 Pastor's Vision for the Church

For 2024, some of the vision I need to cast is simply a reminder of the things we've all decided together through the recent years but we sometimes forget. For instance:

- 1) We're called "Cornerstone Global Methodist Church" because:
 - a. Our identity is founded upon the essential rock of our lives, Jesus Christ, who is called the "cornerstone" in Scripture.
 - b. We're called by God as a congregation of disciples of Jesus who make disciples of Jesus, to live out our discipleship in partnership with other "Global Methodist" churches who are committed to a traditional, orthodox Christianity and an intentional, "Methodist" method of spiritual growth and growth in grace. We will increasingly: worship passionately; love extravagantly; and witness boldly to salvation and spiritual sanctification found in Jesus Christ our savior and Lord!
- 2) We're deeply committed to prayer and all encounters with the Holy Spirit of God.
- 3) We're highly relational, committed to living the Christian life *together* as Christ-centered friends.
- 4) We're "Multi" –
 - a. Multi-generational, with equal concern for ministering to all generations of people in relationship together.
 - b. Multi-style – as we're willing to maintain multiple styles of worship and spiritual growth for those people of all generations.
 - c. Multi-ethnic – embracing all ethnicities as valued expressions of God's creativity.

We are all those things because of many decisions that have led us to 2024.

We are put in this time and place by God to confront the massive challenges before us. Recent events such as the quick spread of the worldwide pandemic, the sudden attacks on sovereign nations, the development of new nuclear weapons, the growing division between rich and poor and between people of different political leanings, the presence of rich and powerful individuals developing outer space presence and influence, and the development of artificial intelligence clearly make this the most dangerous time in human history. We will in the next 30 years have both an unprecedented ability to connect all people to the Gospel of Jesus AND an unprecedented ability to ruin the world and send humanity back to the bronze age or worse.

I have not historically been a fan of end-times declarations because they have always been wrong and have usually been used by manipulative people to gain audiences, money, and power. HOWEVER, what I just read to you is not it's not an end-times-crazy-opinion, it's a fact of where we are NOW. Would you agree?

Even with CURRENT technology, devices can be worn that study our body chemistry and activity day by day, and artificial intelligence software can take that and connect us with all the information in the world on the internet and give us real time answers to our life questions and give suggestions to what would make us feel better at any time. With such a personal assistant, why pray? Just ask AI. Why read the Bible? Just ask AI. Why talk to mom or dad or grandma or

grandpa for questions about life? Just ask AI. That's 100% technology that's already here, it just hasn't been mass marketed yet for Christmas gifts. But it's coming...maybe Christmas 2024...?

SO – we have to be a world-class church of radically committed disciples every year from here on out until Jesus comes back. The two statements of Jesus that motivate me most going into 2024 are:

FIRST: Matthew 24:14, “And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come.”

There will be an increased passion for world evangelism – it's coming, and I feel it in my own heart. We're going to take the Gospel EVERYWHERE in the next thirty years. We are going to be a part of that! It doesn't get more exciting than that! BUT ALSO, given all the negatives I've mentioned – remember: this is simultaneously the most dangerous time in history. Horrible things will only be held off as long as God holds them off. When God says “GAME OVER” the end will come. That leads me to the second passage that's motivating me.

Matthew 7:13-14 “Enter through the narrow gate. For wide is the gate and broad is the road that leads to destruction, and many enter through it. But small is the gate and narrow the road that leads to life, and only a few find it.” We have to protect our joy from the fact that our view will not be the majority view. That's frustrating, sad, and disillusioning – so we must protect our hearts. We aren't called to be the popular majority, we're called to be the holy minority.

Jerusalem in the first century had centuries of God's interaction and guidance. They had the Hebrew Bible, religious leaders, the temple with the presence of God, and then the ministry IN-PERSON of Jesus, John, James, Peter, and Paul – and NEVER TURNED in the majority to salvation in Jesus. It was always, and is still, a minority voice in that holy city. We cannot expect otherwise in our day or land if we're true to Jesus' Gospel.

THEREFORE – all of those distinctive qualities of our church that I mentioned earlier now can be seen to be all the more important. While others turn to AI for answers and relationship, we must develop and cultivate deep, life-long Christ-centered friendships across generations and in the midst of multiple styles of worship and ministry. While others turn to self-centered self-indulgence with the majority, we must turn passionately to prayer and worship and Bible study and accountable relationships to connect with THE Intelligent one, THE Creator, THE ONE who holds the keys to eternal life and death and will end this world some day.

This is an all-hands-on-deck time. Your own role in this will be essential. We'll work together to improve our building and facilities through a REFRESH campaign; we will work together to have increasingly passionate prayer and worship and group experiences of all sorts to root us in the life of God; and we will increasingly, strategically evangelize this whole county and beyond in this, the end times. *Jesus* is the hope, *not* humanity. Tell the world with me in 2024 in all ways we can to all the people we can for all the time that we have left! Amen.

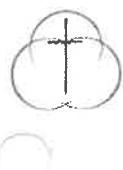

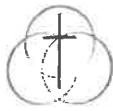
