

Sermon: Rev. Kevin Ridder "The King's Ministry" Mark 1:29-39

O Holy Night



Some have called the Gospel of Mark - the essential gospel. It is essential because of its emphasis on who Jesus is and why He came. That's the gospel, the good news of Christ's life, death, burial, and resurrection. Mark 10: 45 is key because it says that Jesus came to give HIS life as a ransom on the cross for sinners. Halfway through the book the cross becomes the prominent theme. Our goal is to deepen the faith of those who are already Christians and introduce Jesus to those who are not.

As we focus on Jesus each week in this gospel, Mark wants us to join the Roman centurion and say, "Truly, this man is the Son of God." He wrote this gospel under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit to prove it.

Most importantly, our response to the gospel is not right answers but resolve to take up our cross and follow Christ no matter the cost.
