I am looking forward to serving you and your family in Confirmation this year! I love to teach, and I consider it an honor to be part of this important journey and faith milestone with you all.

Years ago, your child was baptized with the hope that he or she would make the Confession of Faith (Apostles Creed) on their own one day. Now that day is approaching!

6th, 7th, and 8th Graders

Confirmation classes will meet on Wednesday evenings at 6:00pm during Lent. Using Luther's Catechism, I will teach the Ten Commandments and the Law and Gospel.

Raising your child in the Christian faith has always been a partnership between home and church. Therefore, we ask that parents attend class with their child(ren) each week, reinforcing that we learn and grow in our faith throughout our *whole* life. After class, families are invited to attend Lenten worship at 7:00pm in the sanctuary (not required).
